- One cohort of students
- 3 year program
- Start in grade 10 in August of 2016
- Higher tuition for the participants

- Dual IB DP and AB Ed IB courses, CAS, TOK Grade 12:
- Dual IB DP and AB Ed IB courses, CAS, TOK, EE



Options

- Each year there will be choice for one elective
 - Arts
 - An additional science
 - As can fit the schedule



Exams

- IB Diploma Exams are written in May
- AB Diploma Exams are written in January or June
