Head of School Report

TIS VISION - Developing a Strategic Direction

The School Improvement Committee worked on the development of the action plan for the 2016-2019 TIS strategic directions:

Staff Passing

We are sad to announce that Elizabeth Belmonte passed away Tuesday night. Elizabeth had been a Teaching Assistant for the past 5 years at TIS. She left TIS for medical reasons last spring. The school will be holding a memorial in the near future. Counseling is being provided for staff and students. A collection will be taken up by the staff to assist the family.

Immigration & Staffing

The immigration issues with regards to securing the work visas with the three teachers have been resolved. Their work visas have now been approved and they are back on-site to resume their positions in Grade 6, SK and Elementary PE respectively. We also welcomed a new Mandarin teacher, Katherine Li who started on October 25, 2016. Remaining issues are less critical but still being rsolved.
