Minutes of last meeting (8th December)

Welcome

Head of Schools' Report (Howard Stribbell - Absent) - See attached

Ms Jasinski gave a report on behalf of Mr. Stribbell.

- Playground has reopened and the normal routine has been put back into place for morning line up and afternoon pick up. Ms Scott added that the overall feedback on the repair work has not been very positive, in particular in regards to the many uneven surfaces still remaining and the quality and state of the soft tiles. Ms Jasinski has made note of this and will bring it to Mr Stribbell for review and follow up.
- Security Status: Parent ID cards will be implemented after the Chinese New Year. It was suggested that possibly a separate ID for Helpers could be created.
 Parking is still problematic in the pick up and drop off area now that all students have returned.
 Double parked cars are still causing blockages.
- Staff Recruitment: Half of the 21 vacancies are now filled. TIS is using a company called Search Associates, which has exploded the numbers of applicants in comparison to previous years. TIS continues to seek a balance of new and experienced teachers. This year, TIS has also changed the Notice Date for teachers to December 1, allowing for more time to seek qualified replacements.
- Transition Planning for the North Wing: The opening of Kindergarten Rooms has been moved to August in order to avoid disrupting the younger children with such drastic changes mid-year.

Principal's Reports

Elementary (Mary-Anne Jasinski)

Ongoing meetings and interviews for recruitment are the main focus in Elementary at the moment. This year there will be more internal transfers. Currently TIS offers 2-year contracts, after which teachers can request to move to teach other grades. This gives teachers the opportunity to acquire a bigger breadth of experience and makes them more employable. Students could therefore be placed in the same teacher's class for two different grades. Ms Jasinski reiterated that should a parent or student have a concern with being placed in the same teacher's class for another grade, a meeting can be requested to review an alternative

- placement if possible.
- Recruitment should be finished for Kindergarten and Elementary by the end of January.
- Division 1 Assembly on Wednesday, December 11; Division 2 Assembly on Thursday, December 12.
- CNY Celebration and Dress down day is on January 20th. (Theme is Asian/Cultural Costumes)
- Way to Go Lunch is on January 25
- The big topic in Elementary this week is the confirmation of H1N1 at TIS. There are multiple fact sheets and information posted on the TIS website and letters have been sent to parents of students in classes with confirmed cases. There is a history and fear factor associated with this strain of flu when it originated in 2008 and was a pandemic. It is no longer a pandemic but a seasonal virus occurring every year and identical treatment is given as any other seasonal flu. The key to containing H1N1 is quick identification. In Macau, H1N1 must be reported to DSEJ. Yesterday, TIS had 1 confirmed case and today, there are 5 (Grades 1 and 4). Affected classrooms have been disinfected and temperature checks are being performed in the mornings. Should more confirmations come in today, the entire 3rd floor will be given temperature checks in the morning. Additional sanitising equipment has been installed in classrooms. Some parents have chosen to keep their children home from school. It is strongly encouraged for parents to do daily body checks of their children.

Secondary (Chris Coates - absent)

Ms Jasinski gave the Secondary School report on behalf of Mr Coates. He wanted to apologise for being absent at the December meeting due to a death in the family and emergency trip back to Canada.

- Semester 1 exams are the last two weeks of January.
- Currently recruiting and increasing staff with IB experience. One teacher has been hired for IB
 French and IB Business.
- Moving into the new wing after CNY. The Secondary office has now moved to the new building.
- Vanessa Wong is the new Secondary School Executive Assistant and will be working on Experience Week in addition to all other administrative tasks for the Secondary School.

Treasurer's Report (Connie Johnson - absent) (Kat Scott)

Christmas Giving Tree: TISPA spent \$6000 MOP to buy additional presents needed for the orphanages. \$1000 was donated by the G10-11 Marketing Class.

It was asked if donations could be accepted, rather than gifts. Grade 3 did a fundraising and group effort shopping for gifts, which was a fun experience. Grade 6 did the shoe boxes, which was great as well, however some clearer guidelines should be given as to what to fill the boxes with.

It was suggested that general guidelines, price range and donation options should be given next year. It should also be marketed better for higher participation and overall enthusiasms of this wonderful initiative.

校長的報告(Howard Stribbell一缺席)一請參閱附件

- 人員編制:二十一個職位空缺僅餘一半。本校起用名為「Search Associates」的公司進行招聘後,申請人數較往年上升許多。本校將繼續尋求新老師及富經驗的教師任職。今年,學校將「任職通知」的發出期限改為12月1日,以便有更充裕的時間尋求合資格的教員。
- 北翼搬遷計劃: 幼稚園課室投入使用日子改為8月,避免年幼學童在學年中期因變化產生 混亂。

校長的報告

小學部(Mary-Anne Jasinski)

- 小學部正重點進行人員招聘事宜。今年將有更多內部轉職。學校現提供兩年合約,合約期過後,老師可要求轉教其他年級,藉此賺取經驗增值。而學生升班後亦有機會再繼續受教於同一位老師。Ms Jasinski 重申若家長不願意讓子女翌年仍然在同一個老師的班上受教,可提出轉班要求。
- 幼稚園及小學的人員招聘於一月底結束。
- 小一至小三早會於12月11日週三舉行;小四至小六早會於12月12日週四舉行。
- 1月20日舉行新年慶祝會及便服日。(主題為亞洲/文化服飾)
- 1月25日是「Way to Go Lunch」
- 本週小學部最大事件為有學生確診 H1N1。有關訊息已上載至本校網站, 受影響班別更有

通告派回家通知家長。2008年 H1N1 大規模爆發引致人心惶惶,雖然疫症現已受到控制,但該季節性病毒每年爆發,與其他季節性流行性病毒一樣需接受治療。儘快確診 H1N1 是治療的關鍵。在澳門,若學生確診 H1N1 必須通報教青局。昨日,本校一名學生確診,今日則有五名(小一及小四)。受影響的班級課室已進行消毒,該班學生每天早上回課室前亦先要量度體溫。若今天再有確診病例,三樓全層學生每天早上均需量度體溫。課室已設有額外消毒設備。有些家長選擇暫時不讓子女回校。學校強烈建議家長每天為孩子進行身體檢查。

中學部(Chris Coates - 缺席)

Ms Jasinski 代替 Mr Coates 交待中學部的報告。他為 12 月份至今因家庭成員身故而需緊急返回加拿大一事,表示歉意。
