
# **TIS Photo Permission Guidelines**

During the school year, there are occasions when TIS staff members may take photographs or film students participating in various school activities. These images provide a valuable record of life at TIS and help communicate the individual and team achievements at our school. TIS may use the images as part of our school displays and in printed publications, such as the Curriculum Guides, Insight Magazine, and Yearbook. They may also be used on our school website, school social networking services, and occasionally for marketing or promotional activities.

- Images will be carefully and sensitively chosen and will not be used out of context
- Images will become part of the school archive, providing a visual insight for future generations of TIS.
- Students will not be identified by full name in photographs without your or your child's permission, although we may wish to refer to them by first name only. Groups may be referred to collectively by grade or house or team.

Therefore, TIS seeks parental permission before photographing or making any recordings of your child. Parents can update their privacy choice by logging onto Gibbon. If you have no objections to your child's image being used and archived by the school, then there is no need to notify us. However, if you would prefer that your child is NOT photographed then we ask you to indicate your choice under the **Miscellaneous Section**, marked "**Privacy**", by ticking the boxes of either **Internal or External Communications**, or both, that you DO NOT wish your child's image to appear. The categories are explained below.





#### **Internal Communications:**

School Calendar A printed 12-month calendar of important holidays and school dates. A collage of

student life is displayed on each month of the calendar.

Distribution - All TIS families

Yearbook An annual publication to commemorate the school year in photos. The aim is that

every student at the school is represented. Each grade has their own collage page including the official class photo. *Note: Unless your child does not take part in the school photos, their image will appear on the class page of this publication, even if* 

you opt for privacy under internal communications.

Distribution - All TIS students

Lotis Magazine An annual publication to celebrate students literature and artwork. Published

students will have their names printed with their story/artwork. Photo images are

sometimes included.

Distribution - All TIS families

School Bulletin Boards Static Bulletin/Notice boards outside classrooms and around the school to

celebrate student work, sports person of the month, artist of the month, etc. Digital Notice boards display school information and school social media posts.

Distribution - N/A but can be viewed by anyone who visits the school

#### **External Communications:**

School Website Provides information about the school to the general public.

Insight Magazine Bi-annual publication to inform parents and the wider school community on the

events of the school and what our students have been doing recently. Distribution

Annual Report Annual publication to inform parents and shareholders on the school's mission and

history, and summarize the school's achievements in the past year. Distribution -

All TIS families, DSEJ, MUST, Corporate associates

Class Websites/Blogs Provides information about the class activities between school and home. Can be

accessed by all families in the class/grade level.

Social Media Social media accounts such as Facebook, Instagram and Twitter will be used

principally to be followed by staff, parents, students and other professionals in order to advertise the excellent work by our staff and students. It will also contain information detailing special events at the school. The aim of our social media channels is to supplement more traditional methods such as school letters and

newsletters, not to replace them.

- 在未得家長或學生的允許,任何發佈的照片將只會配上學生的英文名,不會配上姓氏。另外,照 片或以年級、班隊以及小組等形式發佈。

因此,在為學生拍照及錄製任何語音前,學校希望先徵求家長的同意。請 貴家長透過登入Gibbon系統,為子女進行個人資料私隱選項。不反對學校存檔或使用子女的照片和錄像之家長,無需登入系統進行相關選項。但任何不希望子女被拍到照片者,請登入系統後進入「Miscellaneous」,並於「Privacy」選項旁勾選「照片不供校內通訊 -- Internal」和/或「照片不供校外通訊 -- External」。
